The Book of Second Corinthians

Chapter 11

I. Concern for Their Faithfulness vs. 1-10

- a. For I have betrothed you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ. vs. 1-2
- b. But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted vs. 3-4
- c. For I consider that I am not at all inferior to the most eminent apostles. vs. 5-6
- d. I robbed other churches, taking wages from them to minister to you. vs. 7-8
- e. In everything I kept myself from being burdensome to you, vs. 9-10

II. Reluctant Boasting vs. 11-20

- a. But what I do, I will also continue to do, vs. 11-12
- b. For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light. vs. 13-14
- c. I say again, let no one think me a fool. vs. 15-16
- d. What I speak, I speak not according to the Lord, but as it were, foolishly, in this confidence of boasting. vs. 17-18
- e. For you put up with fools gladly, since you yourselves are wise! vs. 19-20

III. Suffering for Christ vs. 21-33

- a. But in whatever anyone is bold—I speak foolishly—I am bold also. vs. 21-22
- b. Are they ministers of Christ?—I speak as a fool—I am more: vs. 23-24

- c. In journeys often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils of my own countrymen, vs. 25-26
- d. In weariness and toil, in sleeplessness often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, vs. 17-18
- e. If I must boast, I will boast in the things which concern my infirmity. vs. 29-30
- f. The God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who is blessed forever, vs. 31-32
- g. But I was let down in a basket through a window in the wall, and escaped from his hands. vs. 33
