## The Book of Acts

### Chapter 5

#### **I. Lying to the Holy Spirit vs. 1-10**

- a. But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession. vs. 1-2
- b. But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit vs. 3-4
- c. Then Ananias, hearing these words, fell down and breathed his last. vs. 5-6
- d. And Peter answered her, "Tell me whether you sold the land for so much?" vs. 7-8
- e. Then immediately she fell down at his feet and breathed her last. vs. 9-10

#### **II. Continuing Power in the Church vs. 11-20**

- a. So great fear came upon all the church and upon all who heard these things. vs. 11-12
- b. Yet none of the rest dared join them, but the people esteemed them highly. vs. 13-14
- c. So that they brought the sick out into the streets and laid them on beds and couches, vs. 15-16
- d. Then the high priest rose up, and all those who were with him vs. 17-18
- e. But at night an angel of the Lord opened the prison doors and brought them out, vs. 19-20

#### **III. Apostles on Trial Again vs. 21-30**

- a. And when they heard that, they entered the temple early in the morning and taught. vs. 21-22

- b. Saying, "Indeed we found the prison shut securely, and the guards standing outside before the doors; vs. 23-24
- c. "Look, the men whom you put in prison are standing in the temple and teaching the people!" vs. 25-26
- d. "Did we not strictly command you not to teach in this name? vs. 27-28
- e. "We ought to obey God rather than men. 29-30

**IV. Gamaliel's Advice vs. 31-40**

- a. Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins. vs. 31-32
- b. When they heard this, they were furious and plotted to kill them. vs. 33-34
- c. "Men of Israel, take heed to yourselves what you intend to do regarding these men. vs. 35-36
- d. And now I say to you, keep away from these men and let them alone; vs. 37-38
- e. But if it is of God, you cannot overthrow it—lest you even be found to fight against God." vs. 39-40

**V. Rejoicing Because of Trials vs. 41-42**

- a. So they departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for His name. vs. 31-32
