The Book of Acts

Chapter 7

I. Stephen's Address: The Call of Abraham vs. 1-10

- a. Then the high priest said, "Are these things so?" vs. 1-2
- b. 'Get out of your country and from your relatives, and come to a land that I will show you.' vs. 3-4
- c. He promised to give it to him for a possession, and to his descendants after him. vs. 5-6
- d. He gave him the covenant of circumcision; vs. 7-8
- e. And the patriarchs, becoming envious, sold Joseph into Egypt. But God was with him vs. 9-10

II. The Patriarchs in Egypt vs. 11-20

- a. Our fathers found no sustenance. vs. 11-12
- b. Then Joseph sent and called his father Jacob and all his relatives to him, vs. 13-14
- c. So Jacob went down to Egypt; and he died, he and our fathers. vs. 15-16
- d. When the time of the promise drew near which God had sworn to Abraham, vs. 17-18
- e. At this time Moses was born, and was well pleasing to God; vs. 19-20

III. God Delivers Israel by Moses vs. 21-30

- a. Moses was learned in all the wisdom of the Egyptians, and was mighty in words and deeds. vs. 21-22
- b. And seeing one of them suffer wrong, he defended and avenged him who was oppressed, vs. 23-24
- c. 'Men, you are brethren; why do you wrong one another?' vs. 25-26

- d. 'Who made you a ruler and a judge over us? Do you want to kill me as you did the Egyptian yesterday?' vs. 27-28
- e. Moses fled and became a dweller in the land of Midian, vs. 29-30

IV. Israel Rebels Against God vs. 31-40

- a. 'I am the God of your fathers—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.' vs. 31-32
- b. "Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground." vs. 33-34
- c. He brought them out, after he had shown wonders and signs in the land of Egypt, vs. 35-36
- d. 'The Lord your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your brethren. Him[d] you shall hear.' vs. 37-38
- e. Whom our fathers would not obey, but rejected. And in their hearts they turned back to Egypt, vs. 39-40

V. God's True Tabernacle vs. 41-50

- a. Then God turned and gave them up to worship the host of heaven, vs. 41-42
- b. You also took up the tabernacle of Moloch, and the star of your god Remphan, images which you made to worship; vs. 43-44
- c. Who found favor before God and asked to find a dwelling for the God of Jacob. vs. 45-46
- d. "However, the Most High does not dwell in temples made with hands," vs. 47-48
- e. 'Heaven is My throne, and earth is My footstool.' vs. 49-50

VI. Israel Resists the Holy Spirit vs. 51-60

- a. "You stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears! You always resist the Holy Spirit; as your fathers did, so do you." vs. 51-52
- b. When they heard these things they were cut to the heart, and they gnashed at him with their teeth. vs. 53-54
- c. "Look! I see the heavens opened and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God!" vs. 55-56
- d. They cast him out of the city and stoned him. vs. 57-58
- e. "Lord, do not charge them with this sin." And when he had said this, he fell asleep. vs. 59-60
