The Book of Acts

Chapter 4

I. Peter and John Arrested vs. 1-10

- a. The priests, the captain of the temple, and the Sadducees came upon them, vs. 1-2
- b. They laid hands on them, and put them in custody until the next day, for it was already evening. vs. 3-4
- c. Many as were of the family of the high priest, were gathered together at Jerusalem. vs. 5-6
- d. "By what power or by what name have you done this?" vs. 7-8
- e. By the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, vs. 9-10

II. The Name of Jesus Forbidden vs. 11-20

- a. The 'stone which was rejected by you builders, which has become the chief cornerstone.' vs. 11-12
- b. When they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, vs. 13-14
- c. What shall we do to these men? For, indeed, that a notable miracle has been done vs. 15-16
- d. So they called them and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus. vs. 17-18
- e. For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard. vs. 19-20

III. Prayer for Boldness vs. 21-26

- a. For the man was over forty years old on whom this miracle of healing had been performed. vs. 21-22

- b. And being let go, they went to their own companions and reported all that the chief priests and elders had said to them. vs. 23-24
- c. David have said: 'Why did the nations rage, And the people plot vain things?, vs. 25-26
- d. "For truly against Your holy Servant Jesus, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, vs. 27-28
- e. Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, 29-30

IV. Sharing in All Things vs. 31-37

- a. And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; vs. 31-32
- b. And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. vs. 33-34
- c. Joses, who was also named Barnabas by the apostles (which is translated Son of Encouragement), vs. 35-36
- d. Having land, sold it, and brought the money and laid it at the apostles' feet. vs. 37
